DePalma Farms represents three generations of farming in Northern California, since 1951. **Pat DePalma** and his parents emigrated to the United States from Bitritto-Bart, Italy in 1947.

In search of the most fertile soil, the DePalma family moved to the fertile San Joaquin Valley in California. They purchased 23 acres in Escalon to grow **peaches** and **grapes** there.

Today, the **DePalma family** farms land from Modesto to Lodi and distributes its fine produce throughout the United States and Canada. In addition to **peaches** and **wine and table grapes**, they also farm **cherries, olives, nectarines, corn, almonds, walnuts, pistachios** and **persimmons**.

They can be found at various Farmer's Markets in Northern California selling their *farm to table* fresh products.
