WAWONA PACKING PEACH RECALL

August 21, 2020

To our valued customers:

Prima® Wawona of Fresno, California is voluntarily recalling its Wawona, Wawona Organic brand conventional and organic bagged peaches because the product could possibly be contaminated with *Salmonella*.

Peaches sold as loose fruit or in bulk are not associated with this recall. Only bagged peaches are included in this recall. The peaches were distributed and sold from June 1st to August 19th in supermarkets with the following product codes:

The bagged peaches were distributed through retailers in the following states: Alaska, Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Louisiana, Massachusetts, Maryland, Maine, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Mississippi, North Carolina, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia and Wisconsin.

Prima® Wawona is recalling the bagged peaches as a precaution in connection with a *Salmonella* outbreak under investigation by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention that is suspected to have caused the illness of more than 60 people in nine states.

NO ACTION IS REQUIRED.

We will continue to monitor the situation and advise of any expansion to this recall as that information becomes available.
